

RECRUITMENT OF SPECIALIST OFFICERS - PROJECT 2016-17

NOTIFICATION OF INTERVIEW- FIRE & PLANNING – JMG/S-I, AND LAW, MARKETING, CIVIL & ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS – MMG/S-II

We refer to our notification dated 07.02.2017 advising the schedule of the online test for the posts of Fire & Planning in JMG/S-I and Law, Marketing, Civil & Electrical Engineer in MMG/S-II.

On the basis of the performance of the candidates in the online written test conducted on 23.02.2017, candidates as per the list mentioned below have been found provisionally eligible for further process of Interview, which are scheduled to be held tentatively after 22.05.2017.

The candidates found provisionally eligible for interview should be in readiness of the following documents:

- a. Valid system generated printout of the online application form
- b. Proof of Date of Birth (Birth Certificate or SSLC/ Std. X Certificate with DOB)
- c. Photo Identify Proof as indicated in **Point 8** of the detailed advertisement dated 09.11.2016.
- d. Marksheets & certificates for educational qualifications (10th, 12th, Graduation, Post-Graduation & Others). Proper document from Board/ University for having declared the result **on or before 09.11.2016** has to be submitted.
- e. Caste Certificate issued by competent authority, strictly in the prescribed format as stipulated by Government of India, in case of SC / ST / OBC category candidates. (**as enclosed in the Annexure of the detailed advertisement dated 09.11.2016**)
- f. In case of candidates belonging to OBC category, certificate should specifically contain a clause that the candidate **does not belong to creamy layer** section excluded from the benefits of reservation for Other Backward Classes in Civil post & services under Government of India. OBC caste certificate containing the Non-creamy layer clause should be valid as on the date of interview if called for (**issued within one year prior to the date of advertisement**). Caste Name mentioned in certificate should tally letter by letter with Central Government list / notification.
- g. **SC/ST/OBC candidates need to ensure that the community to which they belong is mentioned in the in the Central list of the state for which they hold the certificate.**

- h. Disability certificate in prescribed format issued by the District Medical Board in case of Persons With Disability category. If the candidate has used the services of a Scribe at the time of written examination, then the duly filled in details of the scribe in the prescribed format.
- i. An Ex-serviceman candidate has to produce a copy of the discharge Certificate / pension payment order and documentary proof of rank last / presently held (substantive as well as acting) at the time of

interview. Those who are still in defence service should submit a certificate from a competent authority that they will be relieved from defence services, **on or before 29.11.2016.**

- j. Candidates serving in Government / quasi govt offices/ Public Sector Undertakings (including Nationalised Banks and Financial Institutions) are required to produce a “**No Objection Certificate**” from their employer at the time of interview, in the absence of which their candidature will not be considered and travelling expenses, if any, otherwise admissible, will not be paid.
- k. Persons eligible for age relaxation under 1.1 (5) of advertisement dated 09.11.2016 must produce the domicile certificate at the time of interview/ at any stage of the subsequent process from the District Jurisdiction where he / she had ordinarily resided or any other authority designated in this regard by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir to the effect that the candidate had ordinarily domiciled in the State of J&K during the period from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989.
- l. Persons eligible for age relaxation under 1.1 (6) of advertisement dated 09.11.2016 must produce a certificate from the District Magistrate to the effect that they are eligible for relief in terms of the Rehabilitation Package for 1984 Riot Affected Persons sanctioned by the Government and communicated vide Ministry of Finance, Dept. of Financial Services communication No.F.No.9/21/2006-IR dated 27.07.2007.
- m. Persons falling in categories (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) of Point 1.0 of advertisement dated 09.11.2016 should produce a certificate of eligibility issued by the Govt. Of India.
- n. **Proof of experience** as declared in the online application.
- o. Any other relevant documents in support of eligibility.

The Call letter for the interview will be forwarded to the candidates on their registered email id and message of having sent the mail will be forwarded to the candidates on their registered mobile number.

The individual marks of the candidates in the written examination will be displayed only subsequent to completion of the selection exercise.

Candidates are also advised to visit the Bank's website periodically for any further notification.

Decision of the Bank in all matters pertaining to selection process shall be final and binding.
